The primary function of the position is to support the First Team therapists with the effective treatment and rehabilitation of Boreham Wood FC players.

The role will be based at the club's Meadow Park stadium, so the successful candidate will be expected to live within a reasonable commute from the stadium.

Roles and responsibilities

- Oversee assessment and diagnosis of player injuries, working closely with First Team Therapists to design specific rehabilitation and treatment programmes for injured players until return to play and full fitness is achieved
- Oversee the implementation of prehabilitation programmes and injury prevention strategies for players, working closely with First Team Therapists to ensure adherence to programmes and strategies are maintained
- Working alongside First Team Therapists to implement player medicals
- Upkeep cleanliness of all medical areas
- Maintain all medical administration and files held on players in accordance with GDPR regulations
- Other tasks as required
