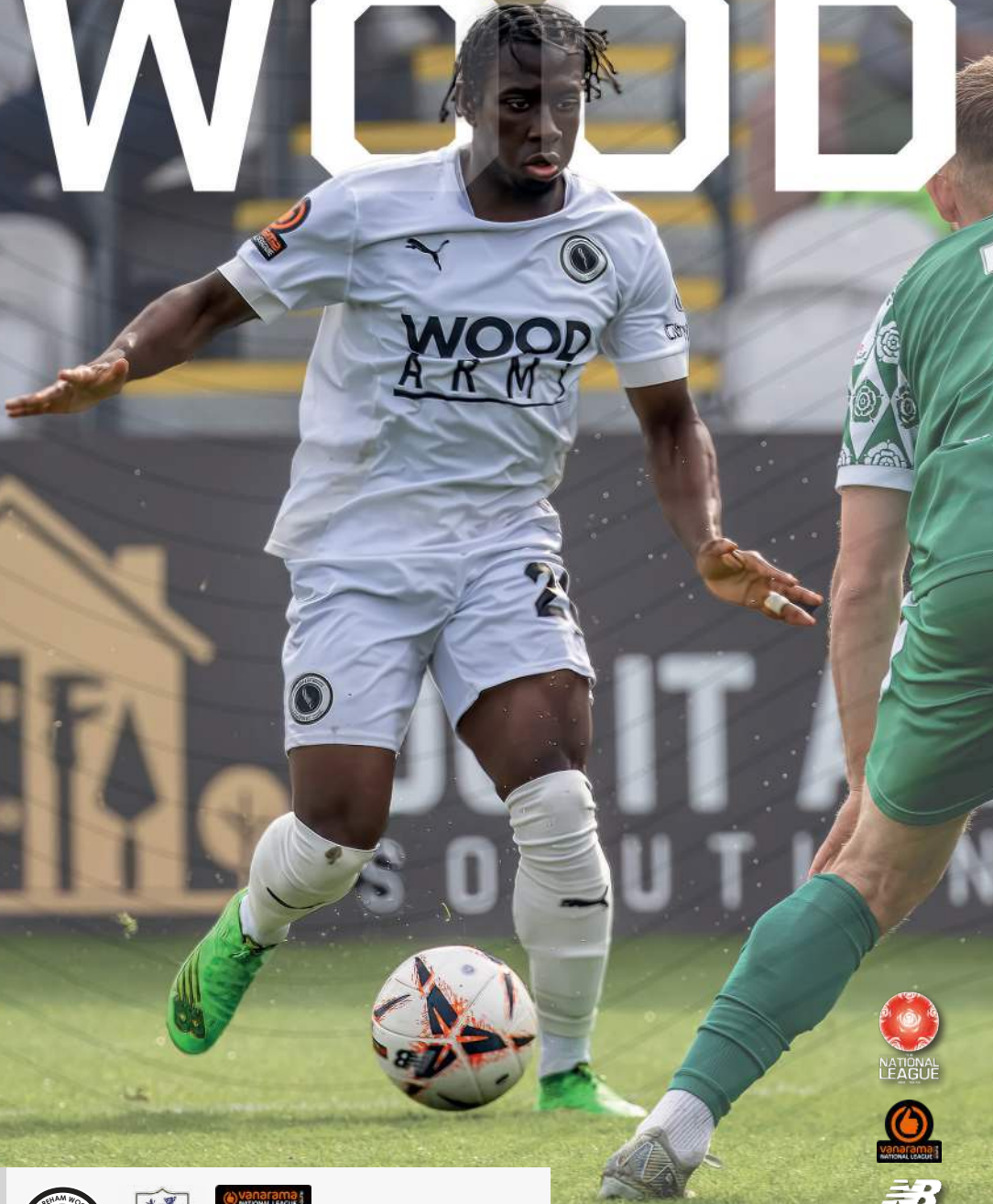

# DANNY HUNTER

*Today, with it being Easter Monday, can I welcome our very good friends from Enfield Town and may I wish their Directors, Manager, Players and supporters a warm welcome and a safe journey home.*

I'm having to write these notes before our Good Friday visit to Slough Town, and we already know what a difficult game that will be. I'm mindful if it's gone wrong that there has been no resurrection for us thus far this Easter, and we could be sitting down in 8th. That said, if it's gone well we could like "the good book" said have risen early to move as high as 4th - please forgive the analogy.

In truth the title went for us some time ago and we've had to accept that, move on and wipe our mouths. That said we remarkably have everything still to play for although things are still very tight in our particular Play-off dog fight. To compound things even further, Weston Super Mare who were sitting down in 8th, were 1-0 down to Tonbridge in the 82nd minute last Saturday when their game was abandoned due to a medical emergency in the crowd, that game was replayed on Tuesday and Weston surprise, surprise, beat Tonbridge to close to within two points of us and move up to seventh place.

We can though only concentrate on ourselves and I feel in our last two home games the team has looked a lot more focused and has played better in the new formation. It looks like we now have more legs, I feel we now go forward with a bit more intent and if we can push on and deal with what's in front of us, then who knows where that might lead us?

In truth we comfortably beat both Salisbury and Hemel Hempstead 3-0, admittedly both at home, and of course that can only help our confidence and with Josef Yarney, David Agbontohoma, Femi Ilesanmi and Charles Clayden all now back, and with both Kwezi Appiah and Chris Bush nearing full fitness, our squad strength is suddenly looking a lot healthier and should hold us in good stead if we get into the Play-offs.

Enfield Town arrive here this afternoon and dependant on what happened on Good Friday, could either be safe from relegation or coming here needing points just to stay up..... hopefully they are coming here safe because



if not it is going to be a "battle royale" with both clubs needing points for very different reasons.

In our last home game against Hemel Hempstead our skipper Jack Payne picked up yet another knee injury and that might have just finished his season. That said, we'll get him a scan and see what the damage is, but for me it looks like a recurrence of a previous medial ligament injury and if that turns out to be true then the diagnosis is he'll be out for around six to eight weeks - so season over.

The bad news regarding Jack does though open up a window of opportunity for someone else and I thought Charlie O'Connell did very well when he came on against Hemel. We also have Mo Sagaf available in centre mid so they, along with Tom Whelan, mean our options are quite good in that area.

After falling away recently regarding league title form, it's been nice to see a new formation being bedded in at the club. Trust me, the players, Luke and associated dressing room staff are working tremendously hard at improving on the detail and even working on their day off on all the little improvements still needed to give ourselves a chance of success.

For me I'm just pleased the formation change has added a little bit of excitement to our season, it's added more legs, it's added Abdul and it's added little partnerships all over the park and also given a freshness and energy to our play and to our mindsets.

For your information, we will have our clubs' Annual Gala Dinner this evening at the Village Hotel. Can I especially thank our supporters, our players, staff, sponsors, local dignitaries and all of our club partners and contractors for attending once again and making this very important club evening a sell out.

Although this afternoon is very much about Luke and the dressing room, this evening is also about you the supporters, our town and our wider community, who make this club so special and it's only through your togetherness, your loyalty and your unwavering support that you give me a reason to continue to underwrite the dressing

room budget, wants and needs, and it is your energy that feeds into our wider community's football ambitions.

After today can I issue a rallying cry, as we travel to Tonbridge Angels on Saturday for our last game of the regular season. I suspect we are going to need to get something down there, not only to secure a Play-off position but to possibly even nick 4th or 5th place?

Remember 4th or 5th would be good enough to give us home advantage for the opening game of the Play-offs which I feel could be crucial. I believe Grant Morris is running up to two supporter coaches for the game and if he does, I'm asking you guys to mobilise, travel and commit to getting yourselves down there. If you do, I'll subsidise both coaches for our supporters so please help us fill them. The price will be £20 for adults, £10 for under 18's and hopefully that allows you all to easily get down there in your numbers, to make some noise and if you can do that, hopefully we can give you something to really shout about.

As I've said before, whatever league we might end up in, let all the noise and any pressure on our future land on me as I run the club, I set the budgets, I employ the staff and with my experience I believe I know what we need, what has worked for us over the years and in truth I know who I want to work with and who I want to invest in.

Your job now is to stick with us, stay loyal, have a bit of fun, stay positive, get behind Luke and the dressing room, enjoy the excitement and madness of the Play-offs and if we manage to get to them and get ourselves a home game, then do your very best to fill Meadow Park or if we are away then mobilise and travel in your numbers.

Finally, whoever you support let's hope for an open, attacking game and may the best team win.

Macpherson joined the Towners for the 2023/24 season after over two decades at Metropolitan Police FC as player, assistant, and manager. A former Barnet and Carlisle player, he also turned out for Wealdstone, Slough, and Woking. Appointed Met manager in 2018/19, he led them to a Southern League play-off win but missed out on promotion in the 'Super Play-off'. Known for developing competitive, youth-focused squads, he guided Enfield Town to promotion to National South via the Isthmian League play-offs in his debut season.

# ONES TO WATCH



## **Mickey PARCELL**

**Born:** 2 December 1995

**Position:** Defender

Club captain and fans favourite, Parcell rejoined Enfield in the summer of 2023, surpassing 200 appearances for the Towners that September. After going professional with Torquay United, he made 193 appearances in his first Enfield spell, starring in the 2016/17 play-offs and winning man-of-the-match in the 2018/19 Velocity Trophy final. He then spent four successful seasons at Hornchurch, winning the 2021 FA Trophy and earning back-to-back Isthmian Team of the Season honours.



## **Billy LEONARD**

**Born:** 1 May 2002

**Position:** Midfield

The Towners' first new recruit ahead of their debut National League South season, 22-year-old Billy Leonard is an agile, forward-thinking midfielder who arrived at the Q&E Stadium having spent the previous year across North London with Hendon, scoring nine goals in 39 Southern League games and earning their Players' Player, and Supporters' Player of the Season awards. Leonard has played a key role in Enfield's fight for survival this campaign.



## **Sam YOUNGS**

**Born:** 21 February 1991

**Position:** Midfield

A hugely popular midfielder, Youngs is now fast approaching 300 appearances in Enfield Town colours and was voted Manager's Player for last season after notching 31 goals and 11 assists in 52 games. He has previously enjoyed three spells at Rugby Town, two stints at Chesham United with time at Redditch United, Hemel Hempstead Town, Banbury United, Ware and Halesowen Town. The midfielder is the Towners' leading goalscorer this campaign.



# ENFIELD TOWN

Football historian **LEIGH EDWARDS** selects ten post-war Enfield Town 'Classic Campaigns'

## 2001/02

Enfield Town won the Essex Senior League Cup at the first attempt in 2001/02. The club was founded in June 2001 by the Enfield Supporters' Trust after members considered that the regime in charge of Enfield no longer had the interests of the club at heart. Jim Chandler's side finished Essex Senior League runners-up, winning 22 of their 30 games. Town gained six-goal wins at home to Brentwood, Saffron Walden and Woodford as well as both games against Sawbridgeworth. Defeating Leyton 4-2 on penalties after a 1-1 draw in the Essex Senior League Cup final, they also won the Capital Counties Feeder Leagues Trophy and Middlesex Charity Cup.

## 2004/05

Enfield Town won the Essex Senior League title for the second time in 2004/05. Jim Chandler's side won 20 of their 28 games and had the best defensive record, conceding just 21 goals. Their solitary home defeat was a shock 1-0 reverse against Concord Rangers. The Towners gained 66 points, pipping Burnham Ramblers to the title by a single point, having triumphed 2-0 in both matches against their rivals. They were promoted to the Southern League First Division East, two years after being denied promotion due to ground grading. Town also reached the Essex Senior League Cup final but failed to win the 'double' after losing 4-1 to Waltham Abbey.

## 2005/06

Enfield Town qualified for the Southern League First Division East play-offs in 2005/06. The Towners began life in the Southern League with a 2-1 defeat at home to Harlow but then won 3-1 at Wivenhoe and steadily climbed up the table

and went top after a 3-2 victory at home to Barton Rovers in mid-December. They won 2-1 at Enfield in front of a 522 crowd, completing a calendar year without losing away in the league. Overtaken by Boreham Wood and Corby Town during the closing weeks, they qualified for the play-offs in third place with 81 points. Rudi Hall was leading scorer. Town were beaten 3-1 after extra time by Wivenhoe in the semi-finals.

## 2006/07

Enfield Town qualified for the Isthmian League First Division North play-offs in 2006/07. Rico Crace grabbed a hat-trick in an early 4-0 victory at Tilbury but Town lost their next match 2-0 at home to Enfield. Jim Chandler's side gained five straight wins in December and triumphed 3-2 in the return match at Enfield. Bryan Hammatt netted a hat-trick in a 4-0 win at home to Tilbury and Town won 5-0 at home to Flackwell Heath in their final match. Rico Crace was top scorer with 23 goals as they won 24 of their 42 games. Town finished third in the Isthmian League First Division North with 79 points but lost 4-2 to AFC Sudbury in the play-off semi-finals.

## 2009/10

Enfield Town reached the Isthmian League First Division North play-off final in 2009/10. They won 23 of their 42 games, winning 4-0 at home to Cheshunt and away to Maldon Town and Waltham Forest, also gaining a thrilling 4-3 victory at home to Tilbury and drawing 3-3 at both Great Wakering and Ware. The Towners drew both matches against runaway champions Lowestoft. They gained 80 points and qualified for the Isthmian League First Division North play-offs in fourth place. Steve Newing's side defeated Wingate & Finchley 3-2 in the semi-

finals but lost 3-1 to Concord Rangers in the Isthmian League First Division North play-off final.

## 2011/12

Enfield Town won promotion to the Isthmian League Premier Division in 2011/12. Steve Newing's side lost only two of their opening 19 games, beating Redbridge 5-3 and slamming four goals past Maldon & Tiptree, Potters Bar and Waltham Forest. They triumphed 5-0 over Thamesmead and Romford either side of Christmas and gained further 5-0 wins over Ilford and Cheshunt during the closing weeks. Liam Hope was top scorer with 26 goals as Town finished runners-up after winning 17 of their 42 games. They beat Grays Athletic 3-1 on penalties after a 2-2 draw in the play-off semi-finals, then defeated Needham Market 1-0 in the play-off final.

## 2016/17

Enfield Town qualified for the Isthmian League Premier Division play-offs in 2016/17. Brad Quinton's side won just one of their opening six games before a 6-0 victory at home to Hendon. They won 5-1 at Canvey Island during a nine-match unbeaten run, also including a 2-0 win at eventual champions Havant & Waterlooville, then gained further 5-1 wins at Harrow Borough and Wingate & Finchley. Seven straight wins in their final eight games enabled Town to finish fourth in the Isthmian League Premier Division with 76 points but they lost 4-2 to Dulwich Hamlet in the play-off semi-finals. Goalkeeper Nathan McDonald was the only ever-present.

## 2018/19

Enfield Town won the Isthmian League Cup for the first time in 2018/19. They made a nine-match unbeaten start in the Isthmian League Premier Division, winning 6-1 at both Burgess Hill and Corinthian Casuals. The Towners won 6-0 at home to Whitehawk in October but slipped to mid-table after four straight defeats before soaring with four consecutive wins. Town won just seven of their final 20 games, finishing in tenth place. In the Isthmian League Cup, they beat Canvey Island 1-0, Ware 2-1, Maldon

& Tiptree 2-1, Burgess Hill 4-1 and Bishop's Stortford 4-2 on penalties after a 3-3 draw to reach the final, defeating AFC Hornchurch 2-0.

## 2021/22

Enfield Town qualified for the Isthmian League Premier Division play-offs again in 2021/22. Leading scorer Muhammadu Faal returned from Bolton Wanderers in August and promptly netted twice in a 4-2 victory at Carshalton. Andy Leese's side won 26 of their 42 games and only champions Worthing scored more than their 91 goals. Town's attack was boosted by the mid-season signing of Jake Cass from Bishop's Stortford. They stormed to an 8-0 win at East Thurrock and shared eight goals at Cray Wanderers. The Towners finished third in the Isthmian League Premier Division with 84 points but lost 3-2 to Hornchurch in the play-off semi-finals.



## 2023/24

Enfield Town won promotion to the Conference South in 2023/24. The Towners won their opening four Isthmian League Premier Division games under new manager Gavin Macpherson and reached the FA Cup fourth qualifying round. They won 6-3 at home to Hashtag United in October and drew 4-4 with Whitehawk the following month. Town won 22 of their 42 games and qualified for the play-offs in third place with 77 points. Top scorer Marcus Wyllie and Sam Youngs netted 67 goals between them. Town beat Wingate & Finchley 1-0 in the play-off semi-finals, watched by a record 2,250 crowd, then defeated Chatham Town 3-0 in the final.

**Wood ended 2024 on a high with a 2-0 Boxing Day win at Enfield Town after a first-half brace from top scorer Kwesi Appiah proved decisive.**

Luke Garrard's men controlled possession early on but struggled to create clear chances, while Enfield's first opportunity came on 14 minutes when Lennon Peake forced a save from Nathan Ashmore. However, Appiah opened the scoring on 24 minutes with a well-taken goal following a brilliant pass from Femi Ilesanmi, and just before half-time, he added a second with a header from Jon Benton's cross.

In the second half, Enfield fought back with a few chances, including Billy Leonard firing just wide and Harry Hawkins having a header saved by Ashmore, but they couldn't break down Wood's resolute defence. Appiah would almost complete his hat-trick, but his effort was cleared off the line. Despite Enfield's late pressure, Wood held firm to secure maximum points.

## ANOTHER BLOW FOR THE SAINTS

**St Albans City's survival hopes in National League South took another hit after a 1-1 draw away at Enfield Town.**

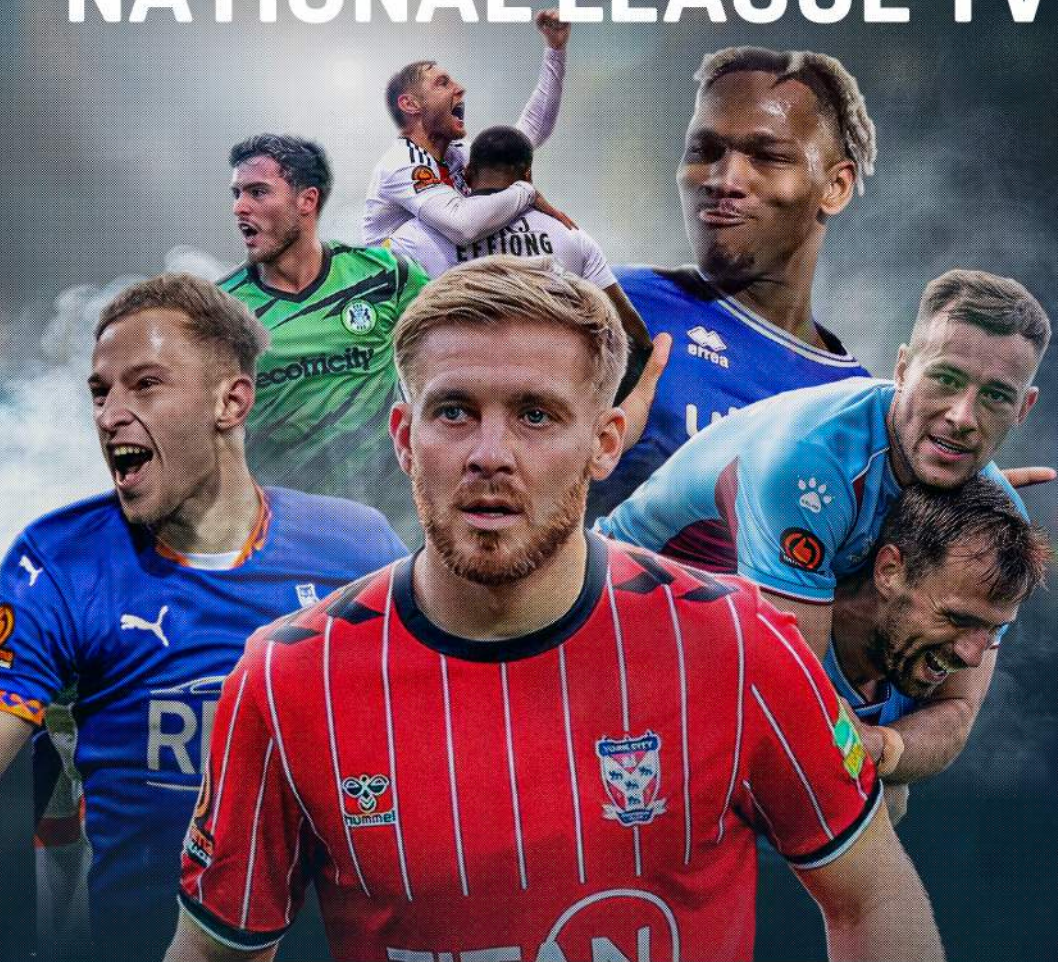
