

To create an environment for 16-19 year olds to progress within both sports and education surrounded by first class facilities and resources. We want to stop talented young footballers from falling through the net and give them a chance to progress their talents with top quality coaching and education.





The BW PASE Academy is a sports and education programme in partnership between professional Non-League club Boreham Wood FC and education providers SCL Education.

The Academy was a pioneer in sports and education when it started back in 2002 and has since become the number one sports and education programme in the United Kingdom for the achievement and success of its students and players for over the past two decades.

At its inception the BW PASE Academy had limited resources and facilities, but its vision was clear: to create an environment for 16-19-year-olds to progress within both sports and education surrounded by first class facilities and resources. We wanted to stop talented young footballers from falling through the net and give them a chance to progress their talent with top quality coaching.

With the BW PASE Academy, our players receive top level coaching from our highly qualified coaches, who not only hold a minimum of a UEFA C coaching license but are also fully first aid and safeguarding trained and checked. On top of this, the Academy also employs a full-time team of therapists who specialise in the injury prevention and rehabilitation of our players, strength and conditioning coaches who tailor conditioning programmes and healthy nutrition plans for young athletes, and an

analysis department who analyse your performances, your strengths and your areas to improve.

Our first class facilities make all our coaching and educational programmes possible, which have been heavily invested in over the past two decades, making them the best available within the sports and education space. These facilities include a 4,000-person capacity stadium, a DESSO pitch within our stadium, 4G astro turf pitch and fully equipped and functional gymnasium, as well as education suites fully equipped with the latest computer software and educational technologies.

Our training philosophy is designed to improve our players in all aspects of the game, educating BW PASE Academy players both technically and tactically. We believe that our programme gives our players the best platform to improve their game across all aspects, better than any other sports and education programme of our kind. Why? Because our track record tells us we do. Over the last two decades we have won more National Youth titles, produced more England Schools and Colleges internationals and progressed more players into the professional and semi-professional game than any other sports/education programme of our kind in the UK.

To put these statements into perspective, to date the Academy has won eight National titles, as well as reaching the final on a number of occasions, competitions that fall only second to the FA Youth Cup in terms of prestige at youth level.

In addition, we have now put 300+ players into the semi-professional game, whilst also developing 15 players to earn professional contracts and play within the Football League. The ultimate dream of every player who joins the BW PASE Academy, showing that with the right attitude, discipline and desire, we can make your dreams a reality. Namely Lee Hodson, Matthew Whichelow, Corey Whitely, Kyle Vassell, Inih Effiong, Pelly Ruddock, Simeon Akinola, Calaum Jahraldo-Martin, Ben Goodliffe, Iliman N'Diaye, Mo Faal, Sorba Thomas, Ellis Brown, Callum Stead and Tola Showunmi, have played for the likes of Everton, Glasgow Rangers, West Ham United, Watford, Wolves, Sheffield United, Hull City,

Peterborough United, Rotherham United, Bolton Wanderers, MK Dons, Huddersfield Town, Olympique Marseille and Nantes and many more established professional teams.

Lastly, we have helped 32 young players achieve the highest accolade of all, representing their countries and playing on the international stage. Of these players, eight have in fact made full international appearances, namely Lee Hodson (Northern Ireland), Matthew Whichelow (Montserrat), Kyle Vassell (Northern Ireland), Calaum Jahraldo-Martin (Antigua & Barbuda), Callum Stead (England C), Pelly Ruddock-Mpanzu (DR Congo), Sorba Thomas (Wales) and Iliman N'Diaye (Senegal), representing their countries in the World Cup, Euros and AFCON finals and qualifiers, as well as international friendlies.

In fact, the BW PASE Academy can boast that two of our Academy graduates; Sorba Thomas and Iliman N'Diaye, were selected to represent Wales and Senegal respectively and featured in the 2022 FIFA World Cup in Qatar, an accolade unrivalled by any other Non-League Academy. Sorba was a second half substitute in Wales' group stage 1-1 draw with the United States, whilst Iliman featured heavily for the African Cup of Nations Champions Senegal, including starting against England in the competitions round of 16. Since then, Iliman has also gone onto represent Senegal in the 2023 African Cup of Nations in the Ivory Coast.

Although we highlight these accolades, we are proudest of the work we do every day with all the BW PASE Academy players, giving them the opportunities to enter further education at University level, whether that be in the UK or on 'soccer' scholarships in the United States of America, as well as helping them develop the functional skills to enter the work place directly.

The facts are that unfortunately only a very small percentage actually 'make it' within the game, and as such with the BW PASE Academy we stress the importance that our players must take their education very seriously, as the likelihood is education is what will be most beneficial to our players and gives them a platform and opportunities later in life, beyond their time with the Academy.



The BW PASE Academy have again teamed up with German sportswear giants PUMA to be the Academy's official teamwear partner for the 2025/26 season.

As a result of this agreement, the BW PASE Academy players, coaches and tutors will be kitted out with PUMA training and travel wear, with all items branded with both Boreham Wood FC and PUMA logos.

For the 2025/26 season, the Academy kit set is inclusive of seven items:

- Training T-Shirt
- Training Shorts
- Training Socks
- Travel Jacket
- Travel Trousers
- Back Pack

When Academy players purchase their PUMA training and travel kit set, they will also recieve a 2025/26 season ticket for all Boreham Wood FC league home games, too.



What is unique about the BW PASE Academy, is not only do we have a direct pathway into men's first team football, unlike many of the programmes of our kind that have no true affiliation to a senior Football Club, but we also have a track record of over 20-years of providing alternative exit routes for our players.

Our player pathway is simple and has four tiers. Some players may only ever stay at one tier, others may progress through all tiers, whilst others may skip levels out completely during their progression. Over two decades we have seen all scenarios play out, and ultimately it doesn't always boil down to the player's talent, but their attitude, discipline and desire.

#### CATEGORY 2 AND 3

We start with our category 2 and 3 groups who play in the National League Youth Alliance, as well as the AoC Sport Leagues, which is operated by the English College's Football Association. These leagues provide frequent competitive football for our players to develop in a professional environment alongside likeminded players and coaches.

#### **UNDER 18'S**

The next level in our player pathway is our Under 18's group. This is a very competitive level, of which we target to win both the league and cup titles every year. This group will also get the opportunity to play in the prestigious FA Youth Cup, and if drawn at home, these games are played within our Meadow Park stadium and on those occasions the players are treated identically to the first team in every aspect.

#### UNDER 19'S

The progression from our Under 18's group is into our Under 19's National League Football Academy group. The National League Football Academy is a recently formed accreditation given to only the best Academies of our kind that satisfy a demanding criteria in terms of facilities and coaching staff. We are one of around 26 academies across the whole country who meet the grading criteria and play within the southern section. In addition to this league, our Under 19's will also represent the Club in the National Cups, including both the National League Youth Alliance and English College's FA National Cups, which we target to win year-on-year.

#### FIRST TEAM

Boreham Wood FC has a rich history of providing a clear pathway from the Academy into the First Team. Year-on-year, Academy players train daily with our First Team squad, as well as earning squad numbers and places within our senior match day squads.

Our staff structure complements our player pathway from Academy to First Team because we also have a number of First Team coaches/players who couple their First Team duties with coaching roles within the Academy. This structure provides great synergy between the Academy and First Team and only assists the club with creating an achievable player pathway to senior professional football.

Of all the progressions along our 'player pathway', making the jump to become an establish First Team player is the hardest to accomplish and should be broken down into the smaller, more achievable milestones. We suggest players target milestones such as, inclusion in First Team training, earn their squad number, make the bench, make an appearance in the Herts Senior Cup, and so on, before making your full First Team debut.





The BW PASE Academy are proud to offer prospective studentathletes an array of different course options through our partnership with sports education experts SCL.

SCL are pioneers in the sports education space, helping students to unlock their potential and supporting them on their life journey. SCL have been doing sports education for over 20-years and to them, success means more than just delivering academic awards. Every year, SCL nurture, develop and educate more than 4,000 learners across the country to achieve in real sports environments.

Through their approach to sports centred learning, the SCL way, SCL's programmes are designed to develop learners with the main focus to provide them with future life opportunities.

#### NCFE LEVEL 1 CERTIFICATE IN SPORT

The NCFE Level 1 Certificate in Sport is intended for learners aged 16 and over and aims to help support the learner's personal development through acquiring skills and knowledge in sport, exercise and fitness. The qualification also allows learners to gain personal transferable skills that can be applied to the workplace or further study.

The NCFE Level 1 Certificate in Sport is designed as a 1-year, full time course and will provide the foundations to progress onto the NCFE Level 2 Diploma in Sport.

#### **Entry Requirements:**

No GCSEs are required however you will be required to demonstrate appropriate behaviours and attitudes towards your English and Maths development.

#### NCFE LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA IN SPORT

The NCFE Level 2 Diploma in Sport (Sports Coaching) is intended for learners aged 16 and over and provides the introductory skills to either start a career in sport or develop knowledge and skills that can be transferred to other industries. This qualification can also prepare learners for apprenticeships or further study.

The NCFE Level 2 Diploma in Sport (Sports Coaching) is designed as a 1-year, full-time course and will provide foundations to progress onto the NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Sport and Physical Activity.

#### **Entry Requirements:**

Four GCSE's at grade 3 or above, one being in English or Maths (this will not prevent entry to the programme where learners demonstrate appropriate behaviours and attitudes towards their English and Maths development), or a relevant Level 1 qualification, plus an ability to operate at Level 1 in either English or Maths.

# NCFE LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN SPORT AND PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

The NCFE Level 3 Extended Diploma in Sport and Physical Activity (Sports Coaching) is intended for learners aged 16 and over and provides the knowledge, skills and understanding required within the sport and physical activity sector. It will also allow learners to gain transferable skills and progress to employment, an apprenticeship or higher education in a sport-related or different sector in line with career aspirations.

The NCFE Level 3 Extended Diploma in Sport and Physical Activity (Sports Coaching) is designed as a 2-year, full-time course and will provide the following UCAS points:

P - 48, M - 96, D - 144, D\* - 168

Most universities will accept the NCFE Level 3 Extended Diploma for entry onto degree courses without any additional Level 3 qualifications, as long as the required grade is achieved.

#### **Start Date:**

September 2025

#### **Entry Requirements:**

Five GCSE's at grade 4 or above, including English Language and Maths (this will not prevent entry to the programme where learners demonstrate appropriate behaviours and attitudes towards their English and Maths development), or a relevant Level 2 qualification, such as a BTEC Level 2 Diploma in Sport, plus an ability to operate at Level 2 in Cost: either English or Maths.

# NCFE LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA IN GYM INSTRUCTING & PERSONAL TRAINING

The NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Gym Instructing and Personal Training is intended for learners aged 16 and over and focuses on the role and scope of a Gym Instructor and Personal Trainer. The qualification is mapped to the CIMSPA (Chartered Institute for the Management of Sport and Physical Activity) Gym Instructor and Personal Trainer professional standards.

#### Start Date:

September 2025

**Entry Requirements:** 

Five GCSE's at grade 4 or above, including one in English or Maths (this will not prevent entry to the programme where learners demonstrate appropriate behaviours and attitudes towards their English and Maths development), or a relevant Level 2 qualification, plus an ability to operate at Level 2 in either English or Maths. In addition, some experience of gym-based exercises, including free weights, is highly recommended. The course requires physical exertion and individual participation is essential; therefore, a degree of physical fitness is necessary.

1-year

# BTEC LEVEL 3 NATIONAL EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS

The Pearson BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma in Business is an Applied General qualification. The qualification aims to provide a wide-ranging study of the business sector. It is designed for learners studying full time who wish to pursue a career in business, primarily via higher education to access graduate entry employment with businesses, or through higher and degree level apprenticeships.

The National Extended Diploma is a two-year, full-time course and will provide the following **UCAS** points:

P - 48, M - 96, D - 144, D\* - 168

Most universities will accept the BTEC Level 3 National Extended Diploma for entry onto degree courses without any additional Level 3 qualifications as long as the required grade is achieved.

**Entry Requirements:**




#### \*ENGLISH & MATHS

Upon programme completion, the skills students acquire will be evidenced by either a Functional Skills or a GCSE qualification.
